Effects of Metro Network on Urban Development in the City of Toronto

Abstract:

Throughout the history of urban planning, especially in the modern time, there has always been a serious relation between accessibility, types of transit services and development of the urban areas.

Considering the fact that transit systems would create the required accesses as well as connections between the different regions, they have important effects on the development of urban areas. Therefore they are considered as one of the important factors in the urban development field.

Metro system is one of the public transit systems that has substantial benefits such as security, reliable speed, lack of pollution, and is also more affordable comparing to other public transit systems, and therefore it will have priority over other public transit options.

Having governmental support through applying the proper policies has been resulted in high density developments around the metro stations, increasing the value of lands and changes in structure of the city from mono-core to multi-core structure by creating the sub centers.

Scrutinizing such successful examples in different cities around the world could help to find proper solutions for Tehran's problems as well as effective use of metro system in this city, and it can be possible only by the right planning and support in and from all the related sectors.
